My teachers will look after me while I am at school. I can ask my teachers to help me if I need help. My teachers care about me and like to know about me.
















I can have a lot of fun at school and learn a lot of things. I might see some Kinder friends there and make some new friends too.












Sometimes I might miss my family while I am at school. Some children might feel nervous because they miss their family but the teachers will help them to feel better.
















I wear my uniform to school including my all black shoes or runners.

Inside my lunch box I pack my snack, lunch and brain food. My name is on everything. This is where I put my bag when I am at school.










I eat my snack, brain food and lunch at school. I help to pack a nude-food lunch box to protect the environment.


This is my Learning Community where I have fun and learn with the other children in my class. I will learn the names of the other children and they will learn my name as well.








I know how to do a lot of things at school because I have done them before. I may draw, paste, count, play, listen to stories and sing songs at school.










We learn lots of things every day. I try my best to tell my family about my busy school day. My family can visit the Prep blog on the MPPS website to see some of the fun things we do at school.

During recess and lunch breaks, the yard duty teacher wears a bright yellow vest and carries a first aid kit.


I can always ask the yard duty teacher for help.







When the music plays at 8:45am, I wave a cheerful goodbye to my family. I walk into Plenty Learning Community on time and ready for learning.










This is the school office. If I ever arrive late to school after the music at 8:45am I will come to the office to get a late pass. Sometimes my family will visit the office.

When I am going home I say goodbye and smile and wave to the teachers and the other children.






After a big day of learning at school, I may feel tired. I will make sure to have a good rest at home. This way I am ready for learning the next day.
