# First Week of Prep at MPPS, 2024



### Before school:

On Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> February you will be able to walk your child through the school gates into the Central Plaza. The school grounds will be supervised from 8:30am. Children need to arrive at school approximately 10 minutes before the school start time at 8:45am. This ensures an organised and happy start to the day. Help your child to attach the name badge to the front of her/his school uniform. Name badges will be located outside of Plenty Learning Community.

#### When the music begins to sound:

Students will be welcomed by teachers outside of Plenty Learning Community. Students will independently proceed into the Learning Community to find her/his name labelled on a locker tub. Students will then leave her/his school bag inside this bag box. Please leave your child at the Learning Community entrance in a relaxed and confident manner. Say a cheerful farewell after reassuring that she/he will be picked up again at 3:15pm.

#### After school:

Students will be dismissed from Plenty Learning Community at 3:15pm when a familiar adult has been sited. Ensure your child is aware about after-school arrangements including who will be picking shelhe up and where you will be meeting.

Children who are pre-booked into the YMCA Out of School Hours Care program will be supervised to the Community Hub by an adult.
